Terms and Conditions:

- The races to which these terms and conditions apply, is being held in accordance with the NZSSRA Rules, Regulations and Safety System, NZSSSC school team eligibility criteria and the 2018 Aon Maadi Cup Conditions.
- The winning schools of each of the boys and girls Under-17 Single Scull events will be awarded a new single scull and set of oars supplied by Aon/Laszlo Boats and Concept 2 respectively.
- The skiff and oars will become the property of the recipient schools.
- The hull design, including Aon's and Laszlo's logos, must remain in use on the skiffs for a minimum of five years from 1st January 2019.
- Maintenance of skiffs, including logo maintenance, must be undertaken by Laszlo Boats.
- The skiffs and oars must be used by the school's best athlete in the Under-18 Single Scull event in the season immediately following the receipt of the prize, including but not limited to, the 2019 New Zealand Secondary School Rowing Championships. In the event the school is not able to race in the U18 single scull event Aon and Laszlo will determine the best course of action.
- In subsequent seasons, the skiffs and oars may be used in any event as deemed appropriate by the recipient school, providing they are still used in the New Zealand Secondary School Rowing Championships if possible.
- In the event that a winning school has an exclusive sponsorship arrangement with a boat manufacturer or oar supplier other than Laszlo Boats, Aon and Laszlo will determine the best course of action.
- The recipient schools agree to make a public announcement on the win with reference to the sponsors (Aon, Laszlo Boats and Concept 2) via their channels, including but not limited to social media, newsletters to parents and school website. The announcement must specify boat provided by Aon/Laszlo, oars by Concept 2.
