

Aon's Terms of Business

February 2018 Variations

The main variations to the Aon Terms of Business are as follows. Mark up of all variations available on request.

Clause 2 – Our Responsibilities

Additional fees may be payable where work on claims exceeds 5 hours.

Clause 4 – Our Remuneration

Minimum administration fees may apply – amounts set out for various types of policies.

Clause 6 – Premium payments and statutory charges

Clarification as to the extent of your obligations and consequences of non-payment.

Clause 8 – International Trade Sanctions

This new clause sets out the obligations of the parties in the event that a transaction triggers a trade sanction.

Clause 12 – Your information

Aon reserves the right to charge for reasonable costs of complying with a personal information request.

Clause 13 – Collection and use of client information

Aon reserves the right to make reference to the client in publications, unless the client objects.

Clause 18 – Force Majeure Event

Where there is a force majeure event, the parties will work together to form a contingency plan.

Clause 19 – Termination

Additional causes to terminate on the part of both parties.
